If the cardboard box containing cracked glass etc. goes into a designated bag, please use a designated bag for each cardboard box, do not apply a specified seal, and please write "ガラス・キケン" (glass / danger) on the bag before putting it out.

Objects with a length that exceeds 50cm and/or a weight that exceeds 30kg cannot be brought to the collection site unless they can be disassembled to make them less than 50cm in length, at which point they can be placed in designated bags or given a designated sticker before being brought to the collection site.
